Are their separate beds for adults and kids?

Yes, there are separate cabins for adults and kids. Adults will be a more hotel style accommodation while kids will be in an outdoor air conditioned bunk-bed cabin. Children are responsible for bringing a pillow, sleeping bag, and/or bed sheets. Adult accommodations will already have bedding.

What kind of food is served?

The menu will be 100% vegetarian with the ability to bring snacks from outside. Meals will be pizza, salad, pasta, and other common food. Breakfast is similar to a continental breakfast

What kind of activities will be available?

Adults and kids will participate in many outdoor activities. The early mornings will consist of yoga and the day will include rock-wall climbing, team-building courses, canoeing, archery, and horse-back riding. If the weather is hot enough, there is also swimming. There are also small trails and hikes for anyone who wishes to explore the campground and surrounding areas.

What is the cost?

Is transportation provided?

Families are responsible for their own transportation. Some committee members can pick-up and transport children if need be (limited spots available)

I'm afraid of leaving my kid, how safe is the camp?

The camp is very fun and our counselors are well trained to handle all types of situations. There are doctors on site and the camp is only 1 hr from downtown Houston in the event of an emergency.
