# Agrawal Association of America supporting Indian Students in University of Houston

Agrawal Association of America has made a commitment to University of Houston for raising Scholarship funds for Indian Students coming from India or from any State outside the state of Texas. If a resident of Texas gives a scholarship of \$1000 to a Foreign Student, the tuition fee of the student receiving such scholarship is reduced, so he/she will only have to pay in-state Tuition Fee rather than a Foreign Student Tuition Fee, which in real terms means savings of approximately \$8000 per year for the student. Students have to maintain a certain level of point Average in their tests to qualify every year for these savings, and of course, are subject to the availability of Scholarship funds.

Last Year following member of Agrawal Association committed to give below mentioned funds for these Scholarships to University of Houston and most of the funds have already been made to U of H.


